BOARD MEMBER RESIGNATION/REMOVAL FROM OFFICE

A vacancy on the School Board exists when one or more of the following occurs to a School Board member.

- 1. Death.
- 2. Is removed from office.
- 3. Failure to qualify as provided by law.
- 4. Ceases to be a resident of the District.
- 5. Conviction of an infamous crime or of any offense involving a violation of the official oath of office.
- 6. A judgment is obtained against the member for breach of official bond.
- 7. Becomes incapacitated and is unable to attend to the duties of a board member.
- 8. Assumes the duties of an office incompatible with the duties of a school board member.
- 9. Resignation.

A Board member's resignation/removal from Board will not be effective until a successor is appointed and qualified as prescribed by law. The individual will continue to serve as an official Board member until that time.
