BOARD SUPERINTENDENT RELATIONSHIP

The Board believes that open lines of communication are vitally important in a successful Board-Superintendent relationship and that the children of the District are best served by an atmosphere of harmony based upon mutual trust and a clear understanding of policymaking and administrative roles.

The role of policy development and oversight is a major responsibility of the School Board. Delegation by the Board of its executive powers provides freedom for the superintendent to manage the schools within the established policies. The Board holds the Superintendent responsible for carrying out its policies and is accountable to the Board for results.
