

SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AREAS

The Board will determine attendance areas for the various schools of the district, as recommended by the superintendent. In recommending boundary lines, the superintendent will take into consideration the best use of school facilities, the equalization of enrollments in classrooms, natural barriers, and traffic hazards and patterns. Except as the foregoing factors influenced boundary lines, the areas established should permit each student to attend the school nearest his/her place of residence.

Students are expected to attend the school in the area in which they live, with such individual exceptions or open enrollment provisions as fall within Board policy or may be made in the best interests of the student and/or the school.

The Board may change attendance boundaries as population warrants or as capacities of buildings require adjustments in student enrollment.
