STUDENT DISMISSAL PRECAUTIONS

The superintendent or designee may dismiss school for any school grade or class

before the regular hour of dismissal due to weather, health, or other necessary

circumstances.

Individual students may not leave school prior to the regular hour of dismissal except by

permission of the principal or designee.

A student will not be permitted to leave school prior to the time of dismissal unless a

parent has granted permission. Either parent of a child may grant permission for the

child to leave school, and a child will be released into the care of either parent or

designee unless the principal is provided with a court order prohibiting a parent from

granting permission to release child into the care of another, or prohibiting release of

child into the care of a parent. If a police officer or other court official requests the

dismissal of a student during school hours, they must have a warrant or written request

by a parent before the student will be dismissed.
