## COMMUNITY USE OF FACILITIES GROUP DEFINITIONS

 Group I - School organizations and school sponsored activities: Student organizations and clubs to include Boy Scouts/Girl Scouts, PTO's/PTA's, Booster organizations, adult education courses, student co-curricular events and practices, Recreation Center and Boy's & Girl's club summer activities that involve district students, (Before and After School programs that do not impose any additional costs to the district), student camps (addressed below)

Facilities will be free of charge.

Group II - Activities and organizations that involve district students:

Educational groups, Boy Scouts/Girl Scouts when charging admissions, Boy's & Girl's Club when charging admissions, booster organizations when charging admissions, local recreational clubs and organizations, organizations that submit a majority of their proceeds to the district via cash donations or equipment purchases for the direct benefit of students.

Facility fee will be based on the special rate (A).

Group III- Activities and organizations that involve district adults: Adult recreational clubs/organizations/teams, adult education courses that are not district sponsored, local nonprofit organizations for non-commercial purposes, service clubs.

Facility fee will be based on the special rate (A)

Group IV -Commercial use, non-local non-profit organizations using the facilities for fund-raising activities, non-district adult and student organizations, non-district schools, state events.

Facility fee will be based on the regular rate (B)

Group V - Special types of organizations and activities requiring individual treatment: organizations renting a facility or a portion of the facility for an extended period of time on a daily basis in which extended lease agreements have been issued.

Facility usage which involves employees using the facility for the purpose of conducting camps, clinics or activities for which students are charged a fee for participation will be limited to programs directly related to a recognized school

academic or activity program and which teaches students skills used in the school program. Use for such school related activities will be considered educational and not subject to the commercial activity classification. The district provides a camp/activity form to be completed by the camp director prior to the camp promotion to insure this special classification. Camps, clinics or activities that are deemed operating for private gain will be considered commercial and will be subject to the same fees as group V.

Any group/activity that does not fit the above descriptions will be handled on a case by case basis with the classification being approved and assigned by the superintendent or designee.

Stadium, track facilities and practice field usage requests vary greatly;, therefore these requests will be handled on an individual basis at the discretion of the superintendent and the activities director.
