COPYRIGHT

The Watertown School District shall comply with the Copyright Act of 1976 (Title 17 of the United States Code) and all subsequent statutes regarding copyright laws governing literary, musical, dramatic and choreographic works, pictorial, graphic and structural works, motion picture and audiovisual works, and sound recordings.

Educators and students have access to information and to reproduce copyrighted material under the conditions outlined in Sections 107 and 110 of the Copyright Act. Reproduction of works not allowed by copyright law, fair use guidelines, license agreements or proprietor's permission is a violation of the Copyright Act of 1976.

Violation of copyright law may result in disciplinary action, and any person who violates the copyright law can be held individually liable for such violations.

The additional use of copyrighted materials is allowed when that use meets the "fair use" standards of Section 107 of the Copyright Act. Guidelines for determining "fair use" are available from the superintendent or designee, and the superintendent or designee shall be consulted on any questions or issues relating to fair use of copyrighted materials. The superintendent shall act as a copyright officer for the District and the superintendent's office shall be the depository for all copyright records, licenses and permission agreements.
