

Ardell/Leonard Timmerman Memorial/Trust Scholarship Fund

Award Information & Criteria

1. Scholarship amount - \$500.00. (Three are given out.)
2. Participant must be a Watertown High School graduate and a member of Lutheran Church of Our Redeemer.
3. Scholarship applications can be obtained from the LCOOR secretarial office.
4. Scholarship awards will be selected by the total membership (5) of the Trust Fund Committee. Personal interviews of applicants may be requested by the committee.
5. Any student may apply for only two consecutive scholarships, preferably the first and second years of any educational or technical training program.
6. Scholarships received by the student will be sent to student's selected educational institution for second semester tuition or fees for the year awarded.
7. Individuals applying for scholarships must enroll in any one of the following South Dakota State supported institutions. These institutions as listed as follows:
 - A. Higher Education Institution (4 years or more).
 1. Black Hills State University - Spearfish, SD
 2. Dakota State University -Madison, SD
 3. Northern State University - Aberdeen, SD
 4. School of Mines and Technology - Rapid City, SD
 5. South Dakota State University - Brookings, SD
 6. University of South Dakota - Vermillion, SD
 - B. Technical Institutes (1 or 2 years)
 1. Lake Area Technical Institute - Watertown, SD
 2. Mitchell Area Technical Institute - Mitchell, SD
 3. South East Area Technical Institute - Sioux Falls, SD
 4. Western Dakota Technical Institute - Rapid City, SD
8. The Ardell/Leonard Timmerman Trust Fund Scholarship will be a yearly presentation. Only the interest accumulation will be used for scholarships. The principle (\$5,000) will remain in the trust fund. Additions to the principle can be deposited to the trust fund account.
9. Any changes in the program must be approved by the Trust Fund Committee and the family of Ardell and Leonard Timmerman.
10. Any scholarship funds not allocated for a given year will be added to and offered the following year.
11. Any scholarship awarded but not presented due to a change in educational plans or withdrawal from the educational institution may be given to an alternate student.

Applications must be obtained from the Lutheran Church of Our Redeemer Office and must be returned to that office by May 31st. The church office is located at 2001 2nd St. NW, Watertown.
