Florence Bruhn Scholarship Application

The Arrow Education Foundation established the Florence Bruhn Scholarship in 2005 to recognize Ms. Bruhn and her contributions while teaching English, art and drama and directing school plays in Watertown for 37 years.

She wrote the Ki-Yi Legend and was the third recipient of the South Dakota Spirit of Dakota Award. In 1995 on her 85th birthday, the governor honored her with a statewide Florence Bruhn Day and Watertown honored her by renaming B Avenue to Bruhn Avenue. At age 86, she carried the Olympic torch as it passed through Cedar Rapids, Iowa.

Ms. Bruhn's grateful students and friends donated over \$13,000 to establish this scholarship to honor her contributions to their lives, Watertown and the arts.

This scholarship will be awarded yearly to a graduating Watertown High School senior who is committed to a post-secondary education at a university, college, technical school, or art institute in the area of theater and/or visual arts.

The award value will be determined annually by the Arrow Education Foundation Board,

In order to be eligible, please include:

- The Florence Bruhn Scholarship application.
- Two letters of recommendation. The letters should include a description of the candidate's participation in theater and/or visual arts and his/her talent, leadership, ability to work with others and potential for success. Letters may be submitted by a theater or visual arts teacher, another teacher, and/or others who know you well. One letter must be from a teacher in the Watertown School District.
- A personal statement that describes your participation in theater and/or the visual arts, and how the arts will play a part in your future, including work and leisure.

Applications will be reviewed by a Foundation scholarship committee.

The Florence Bruhn Scholarship will be awarded through the Arrow Education Foundation at the WHS Awards Event.
