ELIGIBILITY

APPLICATION FOR GRANT

Applicants must include:

- 1) A personal letter stating the field of study pursued, name of the college or university attending and future plans.
- 2) A recommendation from the Pastor of the applicant
- 3) A recommendation from an educator
- 4) A recommendation from a business person
- 5) A CERTIFIED copy of the father's, mother's or grandparent's service record and a brief history of his or her service.

This scholarship is based on his or her military service. Please state or furnish proof of relationship. One application will be chosen for the \$500.00 scholarship.
